01 SUPPORTIVE ACADEMIC COORDINATORS



Under the office of academic affairs in Vision College, currently there are two academic coordinators cum lecturer, Roshalina and Yi Huan. They are assisting the Head of Academic to ensure the college achieves its highest possible standards of excellence in academic. Roshalina obtained her Bachelor of Health Science (Hons) (Medical Radiation) from Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM), while Yi Huan obtained her Master of Science (Clinical Ophthalmology and Vision Research) from Glasgow Caledonian University and Bachelor of Science (Optometry) from National Institute of Ophthalmic Sciences.

In order to cater all the students who aim to pursue their study in the higher education, Vision College provides a wide range of progression pathway to the student. The college offers different level of programmes, including certificate, foundation, diploma and bachelor programmes. The college obtains recognition from local and overseas authority body, e.g. Australasian Society for Ultrasound in Medicine (ASUM), Malaysian Nursing Board, Malaysian Optical Council etc. Vision College is currently the only educational institution in Asia accredited by ASUM and Postgraduate Diploma of Medical Ultrasonography (PgDMU) is the only ultrasonography programme accredited by MQA in Malaysia. In seek of improving the quality of business and healthcare practices in Malaysian and the Asian region, our college is actively collaborating with overseas institutions such as Federation University Australia



by delivering high quality programmes to produce well-rounded graduates. Sponsorship, bonding contract scholarship and loan from IJN, UTAR, Prince Court and PTPTN are available. Practical skills is the prime component that Vision College emphasized on. Students have the opportunity to have their clinical/industrial attachment at hospitals, clinics or field-related industry to increase their exposure to real working environment. Apart from that, in-house training centres including eyecare, physio lab, nursing simulation ward, vision diagnostic centre are available in Vision College to enhance student's practical skills.

Graduates from Vision College are well sought-after in the industry. Mindful of this, HireVision was established as an "employment" portal with the aim of connecting our student graduates or alumni with our industry partners. Vision College successfully placed many of our graduates to work with healthcare providers both locally and abroad. Since 2005, our graduates are successfully employed by prestigious local and international company.

At Vision College, we emphasize on the interaction between the students and lecturers. Such interactions not only facilitate lectures but also out-of-class activities. All the lecturers are very friendly and always ready to help the students even beyond course-related issues.
